

## Sparsholt College

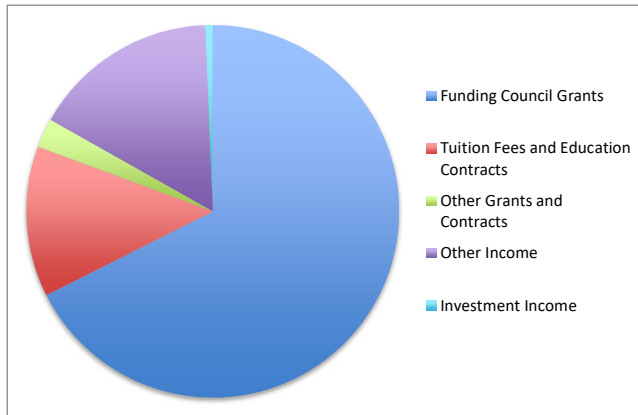
The College, which includes the University Centre, receives income from a number of sources and in 2022/23 Funding Council Grants made up the largest proportion at around 68% of total income. Tuition fees and contracts for Higher Education, Further Education and Apprenticeships represented around 13% of total income in 2022/23.

Income is used to fund all of the day-to-day activities of the College and University Centre, including the provision of teaching and support for students.
